One easy step to completing your College Application,

at www.swccd.edu

- STEP 1 We are pleased to provide a *NEW* format to complete your Southwestern College application. Apply online at www.swccd.edu . Once your application is submitted you will receive a student ID number and important information about Early Admission. If you are having difficulty completing your online application contact the help line at 1-800-468-6927.
- STEP 2a *NEW!* Online Orientation: All new students are required to attend a pre-registration orientation. Become familiar with the new college language and expectations learn about assessment and know how the results relate to course selection. Complete your online orientation at www.swccd.edu.
March
- STEP 2b Mini-Orientation: Is for students that are having difficulty with online orientation or not understanding the process. You will have the option to meet with a Southwestern College counselor. Counselor will assist you in selecting classes for your first semester. Contact the Outreach office to schedule your mini-orientation appointment at (619) 482-6518 or email: outreach@swccd.edu.
May
- STEP 3 Once you complete *Step 1 and 2* you must attend an Assessment/Placement Exam. The exam includes English, math and reading sections that will determine your skill level in these areas and help place you in the appropriate class levels. April & May
- STEP 4 Early Registration: Upon completion of all steps, seniors will receive Early Registration starting May 2010. To register go to www.swccd.edu and click on WebAdvisor. You are now ready to begin your success at Southwestern College!

- STEP 5 Enrollment fees: You must pay within 5 calendar days from the day of registration. If payments are not received you *WILL BE DROPPED*. You may pay fees by credit card, check/money order or cash. Apply for the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Apply for The Board of Governors Fee Waiver (covers enrollment fees) at cccapply.org .
